Planning Guide Washers and Dryers

Measuring your space before purchasing an appliance is crucial to ensure a perfect fit and avoid installation complications. It enables proper planning, prevents damage, and guarantees that the appliance aligns with both functional and aesthetic requirements.

Use this checklist as a guide to measuring your area.

Measure the height of the space from the floor to the cabinet above if applicable. Measure both the left and right corners of the opening. This measurement is critical

especially if you desire optional pedestals for front-load machines.
