Planning Guide Undercounter Appliances

Measuring your space before purchasing an appliance is crucial to ensure a perfect fit and avoid installation complications. It enables proper planning, prevents damage, and guarantees that the appliance aligns with both functional and aesthetic requirements.

Use this checklist as a guide to measuring your area.

Measure the height of the space under the counter. Be sure to measure in each corner.

Front right	inches
Front left	inches
Back right	inches
Back left _	inches



Measure from the bottom of the countertop to the floor in front of the opening. This will account for any new flooring that has been installed.

Left	inches
Center	inches
Right _	inches



Measure the depth of the space.

The purpose is to determine if there are any obstacles blocking the depth of the space, namely plumbing and electrical.



Getting ready for delivery There are a few things to do before your new undercounter appliance is delivered.

Locate your breaker panel and identify the breaker for the undercounter appliance.

The installer needs to turn off the power to your undercounter appliance during installation.

Locate the water shut-off valve.

In most cases, this is located under the sink and is attached to the hot water line of the faucet. This valve must be shut off prior to installation.
